Gallery will be open Saturday 18th 10am - 9pm and Sunday 10am-3pm.

Work to be received on Thursday August 16th between 10am-11.30am or 4pm-7pm.

Unsold works to be collected Sunday 19th 3pm-6pm.

Artists may submit up to 4 works of reasonable size for consideration.

A fee of \$10 will be charged for each exhibited item (\$20 for works with any side over 1 meter) and any work sold will attract a 20% commission to Goulburn Options.
